

HIGH HOLY DAY SECURITY AND GUEST TICKETS.

IMPORTANT—PLEASE NOTE SECURITY THAT WILL BE IN EFFECT:

- Every attendee must provide his or her ticket stub to the Ushers at the front door. Stubs are to remain attached to your ticket until presented. Every attendee, including children, must have a ticket with his or her name on it. You and your family will need to show a ticket for each person who comes to services, regardless of whether he or she attends the services or remains in the childcare room.
- If you are a Temple member, we should already have the names of everyone in your household and will be sending out tickets shortly to people who have cleared up any outstanding balance from last year.
